6. _____ The image needs to be 8.5" x 11" @ 150 DPI
7. _____ The final Collage images need to have white space between them
8. _____ Flatten and save as a JPEG

PART FIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. _____ Take a Selfie with your Smartphone. Be creative! The more interesting the picture the better the final product.
2. _____ Open Photoshop and set up a new document with the specs: 8"x 8" @ 150dpi. Then open your portrait image to create Andy Warhol effect and drag it into your new document. Make sure you create a folder and name it and your image properly.
3. _____ Duplicate layer. On duplicated layer, select background and delete it.
4. _____ Go to Image -> Adjustments -> Threshold (Threshold Level 135).
5. _____ Fill background with color of your choice. Andy Warhol used bright colors.
6. _____ Copy and paste each part of the head into a new layer and change the colors.
7. _____ Duplicate the image 4 times and fit the 4 images equally in your file. Make sure to change the colors to show variety. Save to your folder.
8. _____ Flatten, save as a JPEG
9. _____ Upload to Schoology

2. _____ Using the pen tool, take the images and remove them from their backgrounds
