7	The final Collage images need to have white space between them
8	Flatten and save as a JPEG

1	Create a new document that's 8.5"x11" @ 150 DPI
2	Download then paste all the files below to create your fruit bowl
	Use the selection tools covered in the lectures to take out the white backgrounds

	Make sure the fruits are the correct sizes in comparison to one another
	Save your layered file (.PSD) to your Master Folder

1.	Take a Selfie with your Smartphone. Be creative! The more interesting the picture the
	better the final product.
2.	Open Photoshop and set up a new document with the specs: 8"x 8" @ 150dpi. Then
	open your portrait image to create Andy Warhol effect and drag it into your new document.
	Make sure you create a folder and name it and your image properly.
3.	Duplicate layer. On duplicated layer, select background and delete it.
4.	Go to Image -> Adjustments -> Threshold (Threshold Level 135).
5.	Fill background with color of your choice. Andy Warhol used bright colors.
6.	Copy and paste each part of the head into a new layer and change the colors.
7.	Duplicate the image 4 times and fit the 4 images equally in your file. Make sure to
	change the colors to show variety. Save to your folder.
8.	Flatten, save as a JPEG
9.	Upload to Schoology
